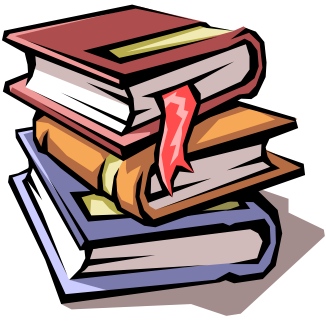

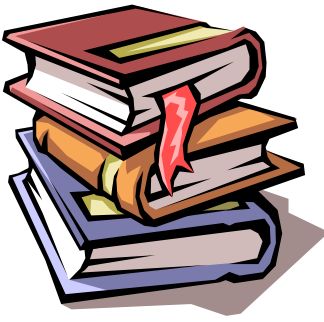
CHILDREN’S PROGRAMS
